AccorHotels works every day to achieve its ambition in terms of sustainable development: to work, through its 160,000 employees, millions of clients and thousands of suppliers and partners, to preserve the planet and the well-being of its inhabitant.

Planet 21 is AccorHotels Sustainable Program, referring to Agenda 21, the action plan adopted by 173 Heads of State at the 1992 Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro. Sofitel Los Angeles at Beverly Hills is proud to be at the Gold level, competing 95% of the Planet 21 criteria, including Meeting 21.

Sofitel Los Angeles was awarded on December 20, 2017 with the Green Seal Silver Certification by the Los Angeles Green Lodging Program. A great recognition for the hotel, now 6th hotel in LA to be recognized at that level for its successful sustainability development policy.

The City of Los Angeles Green Business Program (LAGBP) is free and voluntary assistance program, launched in 2014, is aimed at increasing energy and water efficiency, generating cost-savings, reducing waste, and creating a healthier environment for Angelenos. Esterel Restaurant and Riviera 31 are certified since 2105 for 3 years.

Hotel is currently enrolled in a Food Waste Recycling Program with Athens Service to collect and compost all food materials and process them into nutrient rich compost for agricultural end users.

Hotel also owns an ORCA machine, that transforms organic food waste into liquid, avoiding accumulation of food waste laying to the landfills. The process also restricts collection of food waste made by trucks.

Hotel is recycling all partially used shampoos, shower gels, conditioners and body lotions from guests' rooms and is officially participating in soap recycling program, working with Global Soap Project

Housekeeping gives away all hotel old mattresses which are still in good condition, to the Homeless shelter : house of hope.

All ambassadors are once a year invited to donate non perishable food to LA food bank for hungry people (canned protein, peanut butter & jelly, canned fruits & vegetables, fruit juices, staples such as beans, rice, pasta).
